Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Enteral Access Technologies is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced by Enteral Access Technologies Ltd in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions.

Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Baseline Year: 2022

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

E.A.T. Ltd have been collecting emissions data in accordance with the Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR) for the calendar year starting 01 January 2022, ending 31 December 2022. In accordance with these requirements, we have Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions for 2022 and we have used these figures as our baseline.

The data for scope 3 emissions that has been collected is a sub-set of categories as detailed below.

Emissions reduction targets

This is the first occasion that E.A.T. have published emissions reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 55.46 tCO₂e by 2028. This is a reduction of 5%.

Our intention is to continue this progress to meet our goal of having Net Zero emissions in 2050.

Our targets are shown in figure 1, actual data will be shown when it is available.

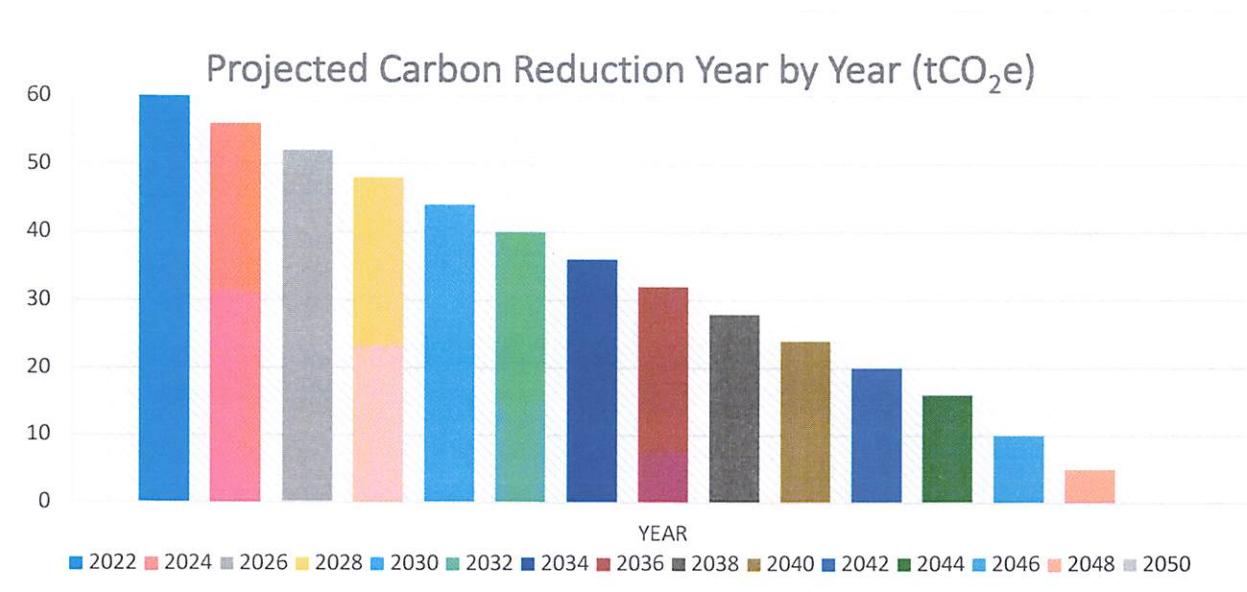

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Reduction Projects

The current reporting period is the same as the baseline reporting period for this year, therefore we do not currently have any data for completed carbon reduction projects and initiatives.

Future projects and initiatives will be reported on in this section.

Planned Carbon Reduction Projects and Initiatives

In the future E.A.T Ltd hope to implement further measures such as:

- Appointing a member of the management team to direct, drive and report on environmental sustainability initiatives.
- Publishing our Environmental Sustainability Actions and Carbon Reduction Plan on our corporate website.
- Purchase our energy from certified renewable resources – subject to existing contractual obligations.
- Assessing our suppliers for their environmental sustainability activities as part of our ongoing supplier review process.
- Promote the use of technology to avoid unnecessary journeys for business meetings.
- Promote increased hybrid working to reduce the carbon generation caused by employee commuting.
- Consider the installation of solar panels or other alternative means of generating power.
- Promote the use of electric vehicles for commuting, using a salary sacrifice scheme to allow employees to join in with the initiative.
- Promote general good practice throughout the organisation with respect to energy saving measures, such as turning off unused lighting and heating, turning off computer equipment when not in use.
- Implementation of the principles of ISO14001 – Environmental Management Systems.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard, and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas reporting.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope3) Standard .
